King George V Playing Field (KGVPF) & Pavilion

Unfortunately, we have seen an increase in anti-social behaviour in the evenings and sadly, some criminal damage. The area is covered by CCTV and we work closely with the PCSO, reporting all ASB. If you are using the park and ever have concerns, please contact the office.

The field is for use by all residents, and is very popular with families and dog walkers. We ask that users respect each other and the space. Organised events MUST be agreed with the Council prior to taking place so we can co-ordinate bookings and ensure LPC, and all users, comply with insurance and Covid regulations.
