6. 23/505144/FULL - 4 Randalls Row High Banks Loose Kent ME15 0EG To Retrospective planning application for erection of a small wooden pergola of open construction, to the upper middle section of rear garden, lawn spikes used (no hard landscaping or paving slabs) (Comments by 24 January 2024). After discussion the Committee AGREED that they have no objections to the application.

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## 7. 24/500120/TCA - Salts Place Salts Lane Loose Kent ME15 0BD.

Conservation Area Notification: T1 Cedar - Reduce height of main central stem from approx. 17m to approx. 10m (large broken limb at 10m). After discussion the Committee **AGREED** to refer to the application to the Landscape Officer. There are not many cedar trees in the Parish and any work to keep the tree would be an advantage.

- A resident has contacted the office as he has concerns about planning application 22/503920/FULL Cornwallis school. He wishes to speak to the Council about the noise issue with the 3G artificial grass pitch. He will attend the full Council Meeting on 19 February 2024 to discuss the matter with the Council.
