8. 22/501798/TCA- - The Vicarage 17 Linton Road Loose Maidstone Kent.

Conservation Area notification: Beech (T1) - To reduce in height from 12m to 6m. To prune remaining crown. High winds have caused the tree to move and it is now forward weighted so the aim is to balance weight to prevent future failure. After discussion the Committee **AGREED** that they would refer the application to the Landscape Officer.
