Roadworks updates

We are finding that a large number of the planned roadworks published by KCC and/or Causeway One Network are frequently changing dates. A variety of reasons are given, and for most it is usually only a delay of a just a couple of days. However, we have now confirmed with WCB Utilities first-hand that the planned continuation of SGN gas works (that will close Cripple Street and Teasaucer Hill in the vicinity of Bockingford Court) that were scheduled for August are now delayed until 2 January 2026.

Issues in Old Loose Hill have not been resolved and having re-opened briefly, it was re-closed by South East Water yesterday (12 August).

Water Supplies

The erratic performance of Loose water suppliers is frustrating for all affected. However, there is huge pressure on water supplies at the temperatures rise. Residents are reminded that **a hosepipe ban is currently in place**. The temporary restrictions mean that hosepipes must not be used for watering your gardens, washing cars, windows and patios, or filling swimming and paddling pools.
