Latest update on the Loose Road Roadworks from WCB Utilities

Below is the latest information we have regarding the gas main replacement and road closures along the Loose Road, circulated by WCB on social media on Friday 16/5/25.

On behalf of WCB Utilities I would like to say that our teams have had a good week this week and making good progress with replacing the mains on the sections of work they have been on and relaying the services to those properties that have had their gas interrupted so far.

You will see more holes being excavated as the days go on but this will be for the next lot of main and services to be replaced. Our reinstatement teams are carrying out back fill and reinstatement of excavations and we will be allowing areas to cure before clearing the barriers within those sections. There will be some preparation work carried out tomorrow (Saturday), reinstatement ready for our teams to go again on Monday.

The teams have received some fantastic comments from residents and MOP and we would like to take this opportunity to thank you, we also appreciate your patience and cooperation during these essential works.
