Loose Ward Boundary Update

During March, two extraordinary meetings were held to discuss the proposals for changes to the Loose Ward boundary. Comments had to be sent to the Boundary Commission early April. For those of you who have been asking what happens now, it's time to play the waiting game, whilst the Boundary Commission reviews all submissions and makes its next proposals. A final opportunity to comment on these, will be available later in the year.

New Planters at Parish Pavilion

Those using the Loose Parish Pavilion & King George V playing field may have noticed some changes taking place during the last few months. Following the success of the planters on the village green (which have now been refreshed with Jubilee themed plants), the LPC Environment Committee are in the process of enhancing the area around the pavilion with commemorative Jubilee planters. The planters will shortly be joined by a new Community Noticeboard and a bicycle parking facility.



Meetings Coming up

The Schedule of Meetings for 2022-23 was debated and agreed at the main parish council meeting on 16 May and will shortly be published on the website and noticeboards.
